



A word from the directors...

The story of Matthew s hepard's kidnapping and murder is one that has been told and retold countless times. However, the collective memory of our society is brief. Though we ourselves were teenagers in 1998, and were aware of this crime, we discovered that we did not know most of the details, or understand the multifaceted opinions held by people in and around I aramie, Wyoming, at the time. you can imagine, then, how our 46 actors must have felt in the face of bringing to life a story that unfolded when they were mere toddlers, with most members of the company portraying 2 or 3 different roles.

The Laramie Project, and its Ten Years Later sequel, present an opportunity for actors that we have never experienced in PV Theatre before. a s an ethnodrama (an interview-based script), the script our cast brings to life for you today is filled with the actual words of real people. For the first time, our actors were presented with the challenge of using not only their personal interpretations of the script but their prior knowledge of the settings and situations presented. They sought input from the authors of and contributors to these scripts, and were thrilled to discover that, thirteen years after the incident that prompted The Laramie Project's creation, these people are still eager to play their part in telling this important story.

With every show we produce on this stage, we dive into the complex process of telling a story by portraying people who are different from ourselves. each process has its challenges and its thrills. But this show is something unique in that producing it also endows its participants with tremendous responsibility. Without giving careful consideration to the attitudes, beliefs, and quietly held prejudices that allow the seed of hate to flourish, how can we hope to keep history from repeating itself? Without talking about our own feelings about gay rights, bullying, acceptance, courage...how can we find it in oursel es to be part of making this world safer for all people?

We are blessed to have actors in PV Theatre who are ready and willing to have these conversations and think deeply about these issues. Because of their willingness to dive into this process, they understand the responsibility they have in bringing this story to our community. We are tremendously proud of the work they have done. We hope you will be inspired to continue the dialogue they are encouraging, by talking about this play with your friends and families, and with all of us who worked on it. Matt's story must continue to be told because stories like his can drive change – let us talk about our commonalities and reconcile our differences. If we take just the first step and communicate with one another, we can hope to understand one another. If we understand one another, we can hope to accept one another. a nd when we finally truly accept one another, we will, as the Matthew shepard Foundation's motto states, erase hate.
